


## SAINTE-MARIE AMONG THE HURONS

Only in the summertime and early autumn



Visit this 17<sup>th</sup> century partly reconstructed village about two hours north of Toronto, where the French and the Wendat Indians lived side by side. Meet a few Ojibwa Indians; learn about their way of living. The Martyr's Shrine is walking distance from the village. Then a five minute drive to Midland which is known for its murals. Would you like a 2.5 hour midafternoon boat ride in the Georgian Bay or a swim in the 'Little Lake'?
